Your Arrival

CHECKIN AND CHECKOUT TIMES

Checkin is after 4 PM.

Checkout is at 11 AM

We give ourselves time between 11AM and 4PM to prepare the apartment for your arrival, following the departure of previous travelers. Thank you for leaving the apartment clean and tidy, the cleaning fees being mainly allocated to the pressing costs.

KEYS

On the day of your arrival, you will receive all necessary and precise instructions, with pictures, so that you can find the accommodation and the carpark easily, and find the corresponding keys.

INVENTORY

We will do our best to make sure everything you need will be in the apartment before your arrival. *Between each stay, we check the general state* of the equipments present in the accommodation. Inform us immediately if we miss something, to avoid that we deduct you your deposit!

To come here

- To come to the apartment -

Here are our advices to come at «Chez Jules», depending on your transport mode :
Location : **91B Rue Léon Blum, 69100, Villeurbanne**

YOU COME BY PLANE

From St Exupéry airport, take the **Rhône Express** fast shuttle, then get off at stop «Vaux-En-Velin La Soie». From there, take **the Tram line T3** heading to «Gare Part-Dieu» then get off at stop «Gare de Villeurbanne». The apartment will be at 10 minutes walking distance !

YOU COME BY TRAIN

From Gare de la Part-Dieu, take **Bus C3** heading to «Vaux La Grappinière» then get off at stop «Bernaix». The apartment will be at 5 minutes walking distance !

YOU COME BY CAR

The apartment comes with private and secure parking spaces (in an indoor garage). **The entrance to the garage is located at 89 Rue Léon Blum, 69100, Villeurbanne.**

Access to the garage is with an access fob. The keys are inside the apartment, and the instructions to access it will be sent to you on the day of your arrival!

CLOSEST PUBLIC TRANSPORT STOPS

- Tramway T3 stop «Gare de Villeurbanne»
- Buses C3 and C11 stop «Bernaix», Bus C26 stop «Gare de Villeurbanne»
- Subway A (red line) stop «Cusset»

AMENITIES

HEATING

- By car : 2 min through la Rue Léon Blum. Carpark available.

To go there :

- By car : 10 min through Rue du 1er Mars 1943.
- Walking : 30 min through Rue du 1er Mars 1943.

CHILDREN PARK WITH ACTIVITIES

Like to have a walk with you children and play with them outside ? There is a nice little park for them with games and outside activites juste next to the accomodation ! **By walking**, towards Gare de Villeurbanne tram stop, cross the tram rails and turn on your left. Continue along the bike path and you will find the park!

BIKES

During summer, nothing is better than taking a bike and going for a ride. A self-service bike station, the «Velo'v», is located at Gare de Villeurbanne tram station.



Take the bike path towards the children park and continue for about 30 minutes to reach the great park of Miribel Jonage, ideal for picnics or barbecues !
Take the bike path in the other direction, and you will ride along the Part-Dieu Shopping Center, the banks of the river Rhône, then finally you will arrive in 40 minutes to La Confluence with its shopping center and its futuristic museum !

CLOSEST PUBLIC TRANSPORTS

To move in the city, you can choose between :

Bikes

Self-service bikes rental «Vélo'v» - Check the closest bike station and all the paths here : <https://www.onlymoov.com/>

Buses

C26 : This bus take you to **Cité Internationale or at the Transbordeur** directly.

C3 : This bus allows you to go to **City center in 30 min** directly, or **Gare Part-Dieu** in 20 min (Shopping center, Public librry and train station).

Tram Line T3

T3 : Allows you to go to **Gare Part-Dieu** (Shopping center, Public library and train station) or at the **Carré de Soie** (Subway Line A, Rhône Express, Shopping center), **in 15 min.**

Tips ! **Download City Mapper mobile app** ! Working in several cities around the world, it will show you where to find public transport stops, define the best and fastest routes, and let you even know when you have to get off the transport !

Updated constantly with infos about road works or else, it is very convenient to navigate in big cities we do not know ! We use it every day!

Visits

Our top 5 things to see in Lyon :

1. **Fourvière hill**, with its basilica, its gardens and its breathe taking views over the city.
2. **Vieux Lyon district**. Located just down the hill of Fourvière, you will find many quirky shops, as well as some of the best typical restaurants of Lyon, the famous «bouchons lyonnais» !
3. **Bellecour place**. It's the heart of the city ! The pink place is ideal to shop and stroll along the Rue de la République.
4. **Tête d'Or Park**. With its majestic greenhouses, its zoo and its little lake.
5. **Terreaux place**. Gorgeous Bartholdi fountain in its center, and lined with the Beaux-Arts Museum and the magnificent City Hall. On Thursday nights, this is the place of students parties :)
6. *One last spot ;-)* Go see the **Confluences Museum**. Even without visiting it, strolling along the docks and discovering its sci-fi structure worth the shot !

THINGS TO CHECK BEFORE YOU LEAVE

- ✓ Please check that the apartment is in the same general condition as when you arrived here. We do an inventory between each stay. If you forget to tell us a breakage or malfunction, now is the time !
- ✓ Please move back furnitures or equipment you may have moved to its original position.
- ✓ Please store clean dishes in the corresponding cupboards.
- ✓ Please fill the dishwasher with the remaining dirty dishes and start the washing program.
- ✓ Leave all bed sheets as is.
- ✓ Please move all the garbage out of the apartment.
- ✓ Please check that all windows are closed.
- ✓ Please check that you have not forgotten anything in the cupboards, washing machine, dressings, drawers, under the beds !

DEPARTURE

After checking that the apartment is in order, please close the apartment and leave the keys in the keybox.

If you have parked your vehicle in the garage:

You can pick up your car before you departure so you do not forget to leave the keys. You can leave the big garage keys on the kitchen table, and the apartment keys in the keybox.
